PROFESSIONAL SUMMARY

Clarence Sawhill is Director of Bands at UCLA, but is also known to thousands of boys and girls throughout the United States as a guest conductor of music festivals. He is currently teaching his 35th year as a director of bands, and during that period, his work has taken him on two trips to Europe, three to Hawaii, several to Canada, and to all of our mainland states.

Mr. Sawhill received his training at Bethany College, Lindsborg, Kansas, University of Illinois, and Northwestern University.

In addition to teaching twelve years at UCLA, Mr. Sawhill taught in the public schools in the mid-west, ten years at the University of Illinois, under the renowned A. A. Harding, five years as Director of Bands at USC, and various summer sessions at the National Music Camp at Interlochen, Michigan.

The UCLA Concert Band is one of the outstanding musical organizations on the west coast, and was chosen to represent the United States on a good will European tour in summer 1962 with major concerts being performed in London, Paris, Lucerne, Vienna, Munich, and Tivoli Gardens, Copenhagen. His university football bands have performed in ten Pacific Coast Conference and Big-Ten Stadiums, the Los Angeles Memorial Coliseum, and appeared in three New Year's classics in the Rose Bowl, with numerous appearances in Disneyland.

Pupils of Mr. Sawhill are now successful teachers in various colleges, universities, and public schools in our country. His concert band members have gone into symphony orchestras, concert and service bands, and into various studio positions connected with movies, radio, television, and recordings. Several of his former students are successfully composing for the school music field.

Mr. Sawhill was selected as the conductor of the 1000-piece band performing for the opening ceremonies of the International Olympics at Squaw Valley. Another recent honor bestowed on the UCLA Band was the invitation to be the one performing musical organization for the Ground Breaking Ceremonies for the International Museum of the Arts of Cinema, Television, Radio, and Recordings, in Hollywood.

This is Mr. Sawhill's second appearance as director of the South Dakota All-State Band, having directed the Band in Mitchell exactly ten years ago. We, the Bandmasters of South Dakota, take this opportunity to thank Mr. Sawhill for taking time from his busy life to share with us his fine musicianship and his inspirational leadership.
