DR. DONALD E. MCGINNIS

Donald E. McGinnis is professor of music in the Ohio State University School of Music, director of the Concert Band, and head of the school's instrumental department. He received the bachelor of music and bachelor of music education degrees from Oberlin College and master of arts and doctor of philosophy degrees from the State University of Iowa.

Dr. McGinnis has held both first clarinet and first flute positions with the Columbus Symphony Orchestra. He has performed with such artists as Adele Addison and Frederick Wilkins, and as soloist with the Walden and Alard String Quartets and the Columbus and Wheeling Symphony Orchestras. His long-playing record, "Clarinet Contest Music," has received highest national acclaim and is distributed by Selmer, Inc. Recent recordings include an album by the Ohio State Faculty Woodwind Quintet and a record of virtuoso clarinet-flute duos in which Dr. McGinnis plays both parts. After nearly 30 years of professional and solo performance, Dr. McGinnis now limits his playing to the Faculty Quintet and is spending time in writing, composing, and recording.

The Ohio State University Concert Band, under his direction since 1952, has performed before the Music Educators National Convention, the American School Band Directors Association, and the Ohio and West Virginia Music Education Associations.

Dr. McGinnis is in demand throughout the country as guest conductor and clinician and has written numerous articles for leading music publications. He has composed and arranged for wind instruments, and his "Symphony for Band" has been performed by several university bands. The late Percy Grainger praised this work as "—the most expressive piece for band I have ever heard."

Dr. McGinnis is a member of the American Bandmasters Association, Kappa Kappa Psi band fraternity, College Band Directors National Association, Pi Kappa Lambda music honorary, and lifetime honorary member of Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia.

We, the Bandmasters' Association of South Dakota, are indeed grateful to Dr. McGinnis for his inspirational leadership and musical excellence so well expressed throughout the 1967 All State Band.

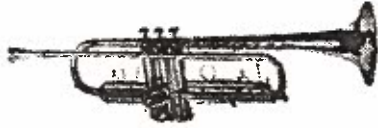
