Maj. Crowell, a native of Mobile, Alabama, studied at Florida State University and received his bachelor of music degree from Princeton's Westminster Choir College. Later he earned a master of music degree from the Catholic University of America.

His conducting training was under Dr. John Finley Williamson and Nicholas Harsanyi and his vocal work with Walter Johnson and Todd Duncan.

Upon graduation from Westminster, he entered the Army as an enlisted member of the chorus. In 1962 he was designated enlisted assistant director, and in 1964 he received a direct commission and assumed his present duties.

## FEATURED SOLOIST

The featured soloist with the All-State Band is SFC Jeff Arwood, Huron, South Dakota. Arwood received his bachelor of music degree from Huron College in 1967 and a master of science degree from Northern State College in 1969. For several years he has served as one of the featured soloists with the U.S. Army Band. Arwood is a noted teacher and has been a low brass adjudicator for several state solo contests.

### ALTERNATES FOR SOUTH DAKOTA ALL-STATE BAND

Students are selected for All State Band by a competitive audition held in ten cities. This year over 1100 students were auditioned for positions in the All-State Band. It is likely that there will be some with the same audition score as those who are in the Band. The following considerations are used in breaking tie scores:

1. Former members.
2. Former alternates.
3. A student whose school is not represented is given first preference.
4. Upper-classmen are given preference over under-classmen.
5. If neither of the above criteria applies, the audition judge breaks the tie.
