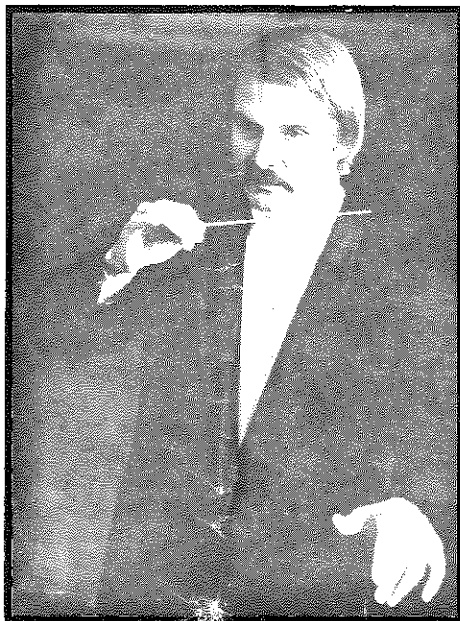

### ★ ALTERNATES FOR SOUTH DAKOTA ALL-STATE BAND ★

Students are selected for All-State Band by a competitive audition held in ten cities. This year 1194 students registered to be auditioned for positions in the All-State Band. It is likely that there will be some with the same audition score as those who are in the Band. The following considerations are used in breaking tie scores:

1. Former members.
2. Former alternates.
3. A student whose school is not represented is given first preference.
4. Upper-classmen are given preference over under-classmen.
5. If neither of the above criteria applies, the audition judges break the tie.
