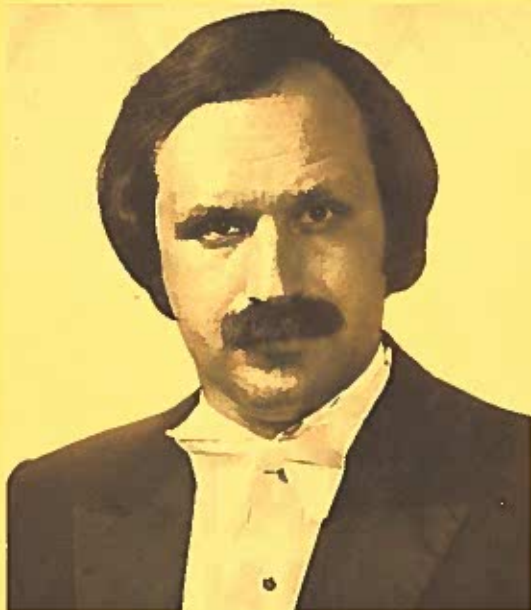

STANLEY DeRUSHA
Director of Bands
Michigan State University

Stanley De Rusha is Director of Bands and Associate Professor of Music at Michigan State University. He has conducted throughout the United States and Europe winning praise from composers Vincent Persichetti, Karel Husa, Gunther Schuller, David Amram, Warren Benson, Ernst Krenek, William Schuman, Joseph Schwantner and many others for his interpretation of their music. Mr. De Rusha is co-author of the book "Wind Ensemble Literature", published by the University of Wisconsin.

Professor De Rusha received his degrees from the University of Wisconsin in Milwaukee and Madison in both education and conducting. His teaching career began in Kenosha, Wisconsin and continued on the university level at the University of Missouri-St. Louis and the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee before he joined the faculty of Michigan State University in 1978.

As saxophone soloist, Mr. De Rusha has appeared with the St. Louis Symphony, the Milwaukee Symphony, the Woodwind Arts Quintet, as well as with high school, college, and university bands and orchestras throughout the country. As soprano saxophonist of the G. Leblanc Fine Arts Saxophone Quartet, he appeared at the first World Saxophone Congress and throughout the country in recitals and concerts.

Mr. De Rusha is presently President of the North Central Division of the College Band Directors National Association whose national convention he hosted in 1978. His professional memberships include Pi Kappa Lambda, Kappa Kappa Psi, Tau Beta Sigma, Phi Mu Alpha, Phi Beta Mu, NBA, ABA, and others.

In the Spring of 1977, Mr. De Rusha created a National Symposium on Wind Music with guests Ernst Krenek and Robert Craft on the music of Krenek and Stravinsky. In 1978 and 1981, he appeared with the Michigan State University Wind Symphony and Symphony Band at the national C.B.D.N.A. convention. Mr. De Rusha can be heard on numerous professional recordings as conductor and performer.

ALTERNATES FOR SOUTH DAKOTA ALL-STATE BAND

Students are selected for All-State Band by a competitive audition held in ten cities. This year 947 students registered to be auditioned for positions in the All-State Band. It is likely that there will be some with the same audition score as those who are in the Band. The following considerations are used in breaking tie scores:

1. Former members.
2. Former alternates.
3. A student whose school is not represented is given first preference.
4. Upper-classmen are given preference over under-classmen.
5. If none of the above criteria applies, the audition judges break the tie.
