Mr. Curnow received his training at Wayne State (B. S. degree) in Detroit, Michigan and Michigan State University (M. M. degree) in East Lansing, Michigan. He taught on the public school level (Grades 6-12) for four years and college/university level for 14 years, before retiring from teaching to compose full time.

Mr. Curnow has taught in all areas of instrumental music including concert band, marching band, jazz ensembles and brass bands. In 1974, he received an Outstanding Educator of America Award and a National Band Association "Citation of Excellence" in 1980. Mr. Curnow has traveled throughout the United States, Australia and Canada as a clinician, composer and conductor. He presently has over 150 compositions for marching band, concert bands, vocal ensembles, and various solos and ensembles published in the United States as well as 22 pieces published through the Salvation Army international publications in London, England, in both the brass band and choral areas.

He has won several awards for band compositions including the Volkwein Band Composition Contest in 1977 and 1979, the American Bandmasters Association-Ostwald Award in 1980 and 1984 and annual A. S. C. A. P. Awards for significant contributions to the band literature of America since 1979.

Mr. Curnow is a member of the National Band Association, College Band Directors National Association, the American Society of Composers, Authors and Publishers, Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia, Christian Instrumental Directors Association, and the American Bandmasters Association.

ALTERNATES FOR SOUTH DAKOTA ALL-STATE BAND

Students are selected for All-State Band by a competitive audition held in nine cities. This year 883 students registered to be auditioned for positions in the All-State Band. It is likely that there will be some with the same audition score as those who are in the Band. The following considerations are used in breaking tie scores:

1. Former members.
2. Former alternates.
3. A student whose school is not represented is given first preference.
4. Upper-classmen are given preference over under-classmen.
5. If none of the above criteria applies, the audition judges break the tie.
