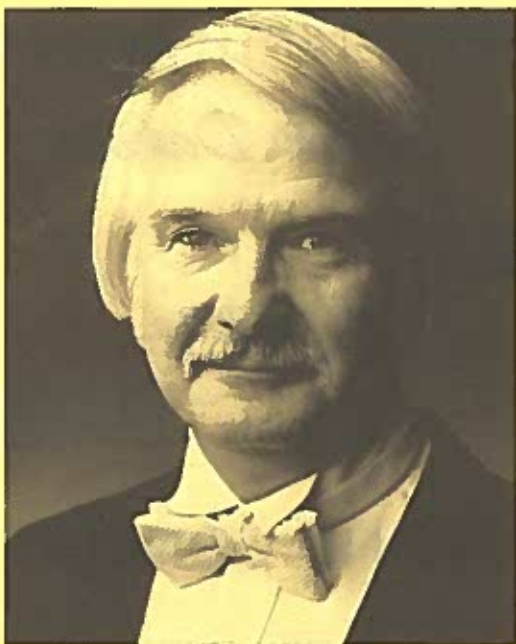

MILES H. JOHNSON
ST. OLAF COLLEGE
ST. OLAF, MINNESOTA

Miles H. Johnson has been Professor of Music and Director of the Band at St. Olaf College since 1957. He was selected one of 10 "Outstanding Music Educators in America" in 1973. He served as National Chairman of the Conductors Symposium of the CBDNA from 1974-1977. He was Director and teacher at the Arrowhead Music Camp from 1961 to 1980. He has also served as teacher and clinician at numerous summer music camps. Miles has conducted All-State bands in Minnesota, Montana, Wisconsin, South Dakota, Illinois, North Dakota, Alaska, Washington and California. He has conducted several college bands including the University of North Dakota, Northwestern University and Minnesota Junior College Festival Band. While Conductor of the St. Olaf Band, appearances were made at the College Band Directors National Association Convention, the Minnesota Music Educators Convention and six European concert tours.

Mr. Johnson appears regularly as horn recitalist on the campus, on television and radio as well as on other college campuses throughout the midwest. He has been a member of the Cleveland Orchestra and the Fargo-Moorhead Symphony. The St. Olaf Horn Club numbering up to 30 participants, was founded by Mr. Johnson in 1966, the third organization of its kind in the country. Through the appearances of the St. Olaf Band in Norway in 1966 and 1974, Mr. Johnson has, in large measure, introduced the concept of the American symphonic band to that country. Since 1974, he has acted as consultant to band directors in Norway, organizing conducting symposia and assisting with music selection and repertoire development and teaches at summer music camps in Norway.

ALL-STATE BAND BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The members of the All-State Band were selected by auditioning at one of the eight audition centers throughout the State. The four audition judges fly around the State to each site over a period of five days and listen to 847 students. From that number the 172 students that are in this year's band were selected. The members of the Band represent 58 high schools from 51 cities. There are 72 seniors, 65 juniors, 23 sophomores and 12 freshmen in the band.
