Dale J. Lonis is Director of Bands and Associate Professor of conducting at the University of Missouri in Columbia. He holds a Bachelor of Science in Music Education degree from the University of Illinois, a Master of Music in Conducting degree from Northwestern University, and a Doctoral degree in Music Education from the University of Illinois. His research in the area of Cognition as it relates to conductor education is bringing him international acclaim.

Before coming to Missouri, Dr. Lonis was Assistant Director of Bands and a member of the conducting faculty at Northwestern University where he taught classes in conducting, music education, arranging and marching band techniques. He also served as Director of the Sports Band Curriculum and conducted concert and jazz bands. Prior to his work at Northwestern, he taught elementary, junior high and high school bands in the public schools of Crystal Lake, Illinois.

Dr. Lonis is currently an advisor and regular conductor of the Matan Music Camp of Israel. He is the co-founder and executive secretary of the Big Eight Band Directors Association and has been an academic advisor to music educators and conductors in England, Singapore, Norway, Japan, Israel, France, Canada, Germany, Argentina and Brazil. His professional affiliations include CBDNA, NBA, MMEA/MENC, WASBE, CMS, Pi Kappa Lambda, Kappa Delta Pi and Phi Mu Alpha.

SOUTH DAKOTA BANDMASTERS HALL OF FAME

ARDEN FOSS: (1915-1977) Taught at Sioux Falls College 1934-38, Bridgewater Public Schools 1940-42, Vermillion High School 1946-50, Sioux Falls Washington High School 1950-66, Sioux Falls Lincoln High School 1966-77. He directed the Sioux Falls Shrine Band, Oriental Band, and a National Championship winning Elks Band. Mr. Foss served as President of the South Dakota Bandmasters Association, President of ASBDA, President of the American Bandmasters Association, and President of Phi Beta Mu.

He was instrumental in getting John Philip Sousa in the Hall of Fame for great Americans. He received the South Dakota Outstanding Bandmasters Award in 1973, hosted All-State Band and All-State Band auditions several times, and helped start the Sioux Falls Symphony.

He was known as a great humanitarian as well as a great music educator. Many of his students went on to play in military bands.

DR. ARNE BALDWIN LARSON: (1904-1988) Graduated from the Minneapolis College of Music and later earned a Master of Music Degree from Northwestern University. From 1943-1966 he taught band and orchestra at Brookings High School. His band represented South Dakota at the 1962 World's Fair. In 1966 he was appointed Professor of Music at USD, where he organized The Golden Age of Bands 1965-1915, to perform original music of that era on period instruments.

Dr. Larson's magnificent collection of musical instruments, which forms the nucleus of the Shrine to Music Museum, was donated to the University in 1979. The Collection was deemed by the National Association of Schools of Music as "one of the greatest collections of musical instruments in the world".

Arne B. Larson was the recipient of many awards including induction into the SD Western Heritage Hall of Fame, the Distinguished Service Award from Phi Beta Mu, the Governor's Award for Outstanding Support of the Arts, the SD Music Educators Association Award, and in 1977 he received the Edwin Franko Goldman Award, the highest national honor the American Bandmasters Association can bestow.

Dr. Larson will be remembered for his dedication to students, his contributions to the Shrine to Music, his adjudication of music festivals and All-State Band auditions, and his simple love of music.
