

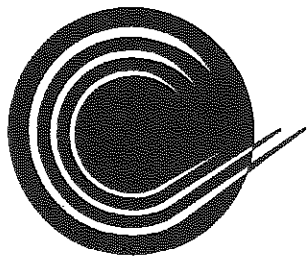

## ALL-STATE BAND BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The members of the All-State Band were selected by auditioning at one of the five audition centers throughout the State. The four audition judges fly around the State to each site over a period of six days and listen to students. From that number the 168 students that are in this year's band were selected. The members of the Band represent 46 South Dakota schools.

## GUEST CONDUCTOR



**DR. DAVID R. HOLSINGER**

Having served 15 years as Composer in Residence to Shady Grove Church, Grand Prairie, Texas, award winning composer/conductor Dr. David R. Holsinger now resides in Cleveland, Tennessee, near Chattanooga, where he is Director of the Wind Ensemble at Lee University.

Holsinger's compositions have won four national competitions, including a two time ABA Ostwald Award. His works have also been finalists in the NBA and Sudler competitions. Educated at Central Methodist College, Fayette, Missouri; Central Missouri State University, Warrensburg and the University of Kansas, Lawrence, Holsinger was recently honored with an honorary Doctorate and the Gustavus Fine Arts Medallion, from Gustavus Adolphus College in Minnesota. Holsinger was also named a National Patron of Delta Omicron Music Fraternity and in the summer of 1998, the United States Air Force Band of the West featured Holsinger as the HERITAGE VI composer during the Texas Bandmasters Association convention in San Antonio. This prestigious series celebrating American wind composers was founded in 1992 and has previously honored Morton Gould, Ron Nelson, Robert Jager, W. Francis McBeth, and Roger Nixon. An elected member of the American Bandmasters Association, Holsinger's recent honors include the Distinguished Music Alumni Award from Central Missouri State, CIDA'S 1999 Director of the Year Citation and Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia's Orpheus Award. This past spring, Holsinger served as Distinguished Composer in Residence at Georgia Southern University, Statesboro, and held the Acuff Chair of Excellence in the Creative Arts at Austin Peay State University, Clarksville, Tennessee.

In addition to his university duties, Holsinger spends much of his energies as guest composer and conductor with All State organizations, professional bands, and university ensembles throughout the United States.

## SPECIAL PRESENTATIONS

During this evening's concert various special presentations will be made. Included in these presentations will be the induction of one individual into the SDBA "Hall of Fame".

### SOUTH DAKOTA BANDMASTERS HALL OF FAME

#### Dr. Darwin Walker

Dr. Darwin Walker began his teaching career in 1959 and taught at the high school level for six years in Bristol and Mobridge, South Dakota. In 1965 he began teaching at Northern State College as director of bands. He performed his directing duties at NSC for eight years while also earning his doctorate degree.

In 1973, Dr Walker accepted the position of director of bands at South Dakota State University. Dr. Walker continued to direct and teach as SDSU until his retirement in 1996.

Dr. Walker was involved in many other activities, which promoted music education in our state. He organized the first Marching Band Festival in Brookings for the Optimist Club. He directed the festival for 18 years. He has served as a South Dakota All-State Band judge for sixteen years and still continues to do so. He served as the camp director for the All State Music Camp for 20 years. He was the first to sponsor clinics in South Dakota for band directors to learn instructional skills in color guard and writing field shows. He originated and coordinated the Music Merchandising program at SDSU from 1985 to 1996. He served as Music Director of the Mid-West Ambassadors of Music European Tour for eight years.

He also authored *Teaching Music: Managing the Successful Music Program*, published by Schirmer Books in 1989.
